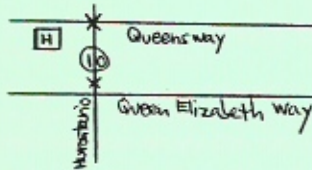

#### CHLA VIDEO-TELECONFERENCE:

The University Hospital in London has been studying the feasibility of developing video-teleconferencing services. Through the efforts of their librarian, Sue Gillespie, and Dorothy Fitzgerald, librarian at the College of Family Physicians of Canada, the Canadian Health Libraries Association was offered a demonstration video-teleconference.

The conference was held on January 18th, 1983 and several TMLG members participated. The programme originated from the University Hospital in London and was televised to the Bell conference studios in Toronto, Montreal and Ottawa. There was a two-way audio hook up between all the centres. The participants in London could be seen by all, but only Toronto and London had two-way video.

Video-teleconferencing is still in the developmental phase, but its possibilities are exciting. Professionals will be able to attend meetings and conferences without having to worry about travel time and expenses. The CHLA tele-conference went well and Sue Gillespie and Dorothy Fitzgerald will give a full report at the CHLA meeting in Winnipeg. There should also be a report in a future issue of the BMC.

##### ACADEMY OF MEDICINE:
